



# KING WILLIAM ROAD UPGRADE

# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – 24 MAY 2019 Important information – Upcoming night works along King William Road, including temporary road closures

Dear Resident / Business Owner

Construction works have now started on the King William Road Upgrade Project which will transform the main street. Prior to commencing the kerbing and paving works on King William Road, works to install stormwater and drainage pipework and pits, and multiple service connections are required.

# What we're doing:

- Installing six (6) stormwater and five (5) communications and power infrastructure crossings across King William Road in various locations; between Park Street and Mary Street.
- Excavating a common services trench for multiple services relocations, along both the western and eastern sides of King William Road between the Park Street and Mitchell Street Intersection and Arthur Street.

#### When it's happening:

Works will be undertaken between 7pm and 6am each night from Thursday 30 May to Thursday 20 June 2019, subject to weather conditions.

Works will only occur from Sunday night to Thursday night, with no works being undertaken on Friday and Saturday nights.

King William Road and side streets where works are in progress, will be temporarily reinstated each morning and re-opened to traffic by 6am each day.

Some daytime finishing works may be required under localised lane closures. Advance notification will be provided to directly affected properties if this occurs.

# Traffic impacts and access:

During these works, traffic and speed restrictions will apply with some temporary road closures of King William Road and adjacent side streets to safely complete these works.

- Sections of King William Road will be intermittently closed to vehicular traffic at different times for approximately two (2) to three (3) nights to install the stormwater and new electrical and communications infrastructure. Works will be coordinated to minimise disruption.
  - The first closure of King William Road will be near Walter Street on Thursday 30 May.







• Side streets at King William Road will also be intermittently **closed** to vehicular traffic at different times for up to three (3) nights to excavate a common services trench.

Advance warning and other traffic signage will be in place to alert road users and pedestrians to the temporary changes to traffic conditions.

Driveway access to properties will be maintained, and pedestrian access will continue to be provided at all times. Traffic controllers will also be on site to assist motorists and pedestrians to move through the area. Some minor parking restrictions in the immediate vicinity of works each night will also be required.

## Impacts to Adelaide Metro bus services:

Temporary changes to bus routes and detours will apply during these night works. 200, 200B and 200C bus services will be detoured between 7pm and 6am from Sunday to Thursday nights only, via Northgate Street, Unley Road and Greenhill Road and Peacock Road. **Bus services will operate as normal outside the work hours, including Friday and Saturday nights.** 

Signage at bus stops will alert public transport users to these changes and alternative arrangements. For more information, please visit: www.adelaidemetro.com.au

#### How we will keep you informed

Businesses and residents adjacent to the works area will be doorknocked to discuss any direct impacts from these works.

As works progress, residents and businesses on, or adjacent to the side streets which will be temporarily closed for the common services excavation works will also receive advance notification of these dates.

Some noise can be expected at times from these works, however it will be managed to minimise disruption where possible.
