
# TRANSFORMING YOUR KING WILLIAM ROAD THE JOURNEY SO FAR


Suggestions and feedback gained from more than 600 conversations with traders, residents, property owners and precinct visitors throughout 2018 have informed the vision for the new King William Road.



#### The three-stage engagement included:


- 1 Shared vision and aspirations

- 3 Reviewing the preferred concept design









# TRANSFORMING YOUR KING WILLIAM ROAD THE CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

The upgrade of King William Road, between the Park/Mitchell St intersection and Arthur St, will be carried out in four key stages.




### STAGE 1 - PARK & MITCHELL STREET INTERSECTION



#### Commencing May 2019

Construction of the King William Road, Park Street and Mitchell Street intersection


#### STAGE 2 - WESTERN KERB LINE



#### **Commencing June 2019**

Construction of the western kerb line


### STAGE 3 - CENTRAL PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT



#### Commencing July 2019

Construction of the paved roadway

### STAGE 4 - SHARED SPACES & FOOTPATHS




#### **Commencing August 2019**

Construction of the flexible zone and paving up to shop fronts on both sides

Note: The timing of the works is indicative only and may be subject to change, depending on weather conditions and technical requirements. Confirmation of the timing of these works will be provided to the community (traders, landlords and residents) approximately 3 weeks prior to commencement and will be updated as works progress.

The City of Unley is proud to work with traders, property owners and the community to transform King William Road into Adelaide's most loved main street.

#### HOW WE GOT HERE

The design concept responds to feedback from traders, landlords, residents and the wider community to create a more beautiful, accessible and active main street, identifying the need to:

- 1 Improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians, cyclists and commuters
- 2 Increase green spaces and tree plantings
- 3 Increase places for people
- 4 Preserve the precinct's distinct heritage feel

The community provided feedback on their preferred option, which the Council endorsed in August 2018.

#### WHAT WE WILL DELIVER

Between May 2019 and February 2020, we will deliver a vibrant new precinct that serves changing community needs.

Businesses will remain open during construction and we encourage you to continue to show your support during this time.



City of Unley and BMD are working closely with all stakeholders to ensure the community are kept up to date throughout the upgrade and are informed about what has, and what will be happening. Pedestrian access to local businesses and residential properties will be maintained throughout construction.

### A DEDICATED STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT TEAM

A team focused on managing the needs of stakeholders during the upgrade has been established to:


Providing advance notice of new stages of construction, including location, type of works, duration, temporary road changes, detours and changes to parking and access


Regularly updating the community about the works and providing advance notice about any temporary disruptions that may impact local businesses, residents and road users
