



# KING WILLIAM ROAD UPGRADE

### CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: IMPORTANT INFORMATION – 1 AUGUST 2019

## STAGE 4 – Shared space and shop front works August - December 2019

Dear Resident / Business Operator

Construction works for the King William Road Upgrade which will transform the main street are progressing well. Asphalting, installation of the new eastern kerb and paving of the road, following the four-week road closure period, is on track to be completed and for King William Road to reopen to traffic from 6am Monday 5 August.

The purpose of this update is to provide you with advance notice of upcoming works including the work to complete the shared space and footpath.

Pedestrian access will be maintained to all businesses during these works.

### King William Road will be OPEN FOR BUSINESS.

#### What we are doing:

Completing services installation in the shared space, compacting the subgrade in preparation for the new pavers, installing irrigation, tree cells and the new pavers.

#### When it's happening:

Works will mainly take place during the day with some night works required to complete the footpath works at the doorways of some businesses (dependent on business trading hours).

You can expect to see small excavators and bobcats preparing subgrade and loaders and forklifts delivering sand and pavers to work crews working in a number of locations across the project area.

The works will commence at the four corners of the Park / Mitchell Street intersection and will move to the shared space and footpath on the western side of King William Road and move north, followed by the eastern side. To complete these works there will be a number of crews working in different locations at the same time, and as opportunities arise they may move to complete the works in front of a group of businesses with the same or similar opening hours.

When work is occurring either side of a doorway to a business, pedestrians may be guided from the existing footpath to the shared space and into the doorway to access the business. Pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained at all times during these works. Advance notice will be given prior to works immediately in front of business and residents' doorways. These works will be planned to occur outside business operating hours.

BMD is committed to keeping construction impacts to a minimum. The timing and sequencing of the works are subject to business operating hours and weather conditions. Advance notice will be provided if there are changes to the program which will have an impact on businesses or residents.

#### Traffic restrictions and access:

# From 6am Monday 5 August to 2 December 2019:

- Two-way traffic, city bound (northbound) and southbound on King William Road will be maintained:
  - o via one lane at the work zone(s) between 9am and 3pm and between 7pm and 6am
  - via two lanes outside of these hours (one lane north bound, one lane south bound).

- Left and right turns from King William Road into local side streets will be maintained.
- Access on to King William Road from local side streets <u>will be maintained</u>. Delays may be experienced when traffic on King William Road is one direction at a time.
- The junction of Boffa Street with King William Road will remain closed until Monday 2 December 2019.
- On-street car parking on <u>both sides</u> of King William Road from the Park/Mitchell Street intersection to Arthur Street <u>will not be permitted</u>.
- The Park/Mitchell Street intersection will be **open** to vehicles for all north/south and east/west movements through the intersection.
- Driveway access to properties and access to off-street car parking accessed via King William Road on the
  western side followed by the eastern side <u>may be restricted for short periods</u> while shared space and
  footpath works are completed. Advance notice via SMS alert or other electronic communication will be
  provided to those directly affected.

Advance warning and other traffic signage will be in place to alert road users to the temporary changes to traffic conditions and detour routes.

Pedestrian access across King William Road <u>will be maintained</u> and designated pedestrian crossings will be line-marked. Traffic controllers will be available on site to assist pedestrians where works are occurring.

Refer to the City of Unley parking information plan for parking available within a short 5-minute walk.

#### Impacts to Adelaide Metro bus services:

#### Kerbside collection of waste:

During these works, City of Unley kerbside general waste, recycling and organics bins normally placed on King William Road for collection should be placed on the nearest side street. Kerbside collection on the western side of King William Road is on a Tuesday and on the eastern side on a Wednesday.
