# Upcoming works requiring temporary closures of the Park / Mitchell Street intersection to traffic

Dear Resident / Business Operator

The King William Road Upgrade is progressing well and every endeavour is being made to work towards an early finish.

An opportunity to accelerate the works program has been identified which involves the **temporary** closure of the Park / Mitchell Street intersection from <u>11pm on Sunday</u> <u>29 September to 6am on Friday 4 October</u>. These dates have been specifically chosen to coincide with school holidays.

The purpose of this notice is to provide you with advance notice that there will be a **temporary closure** of the King William Road intersection with Park Street and Mitchell Street to vehicle traffic while work is undertaken to install new traffic signals and upgrade lighting.

Footpaths will remain open and pedestrian access will be maintained to all businesses.

## King William Road will be OPEN FOR BUSINESS with local traffic detours in place.

### What we are doing:

Works during the temporary closure of the intersection will include installing new traffic signal/light poles, paving of shared spaces and footpaths and upgrading street lighting.

This activity will result in periods of noise and some dust. The works will be managed to minimise disruption as much as possible, however you are advised to close your doors and windows during this activity.

#### When it's happening:

The works at the Park / Mitchell Street intersection will take place both day and night from 11pm Sunday 29 September to 6am Friday 4 October 2019, subject to weather.

### **Traffic impacts and access:**

The intersection (only) of King William Road, Park Street and Mitchell Streets will be <u>temporarily closed</u> to vehicles for all north/south and east/west movements through the intersection during the nominated dates and times. The intersection will re-open to traffic by 6am Friday 4 October.

Through traffic will be detoured via Northgate Street, Unley Road and Greenhill Road to Peacock Road. Local traffic including vehicles accessing local businesses will be detoured via local roads. King William Road either side of the intersection will remain open to traffic.

Advance warning and other traffic signage will be in place to alert road users to the temporary changes to traffic conditions and detour routes.

Driveway access to properties and off-street parking will be maintained and traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists and pedestrians.

#### Impacts to Adelaide Metro bus services:

Temporary changes to bus routes and detours will apply during the works periods. Bus services 200, 200B and 200C will be detoured between 11pm Sunday 29 September to 6am Friday 4 October, via Northgate Street, Unley Road and Greenhill Road to Peacock Road.
